Applicants should consult their districts as early as possible to learn about relevant procedures and deadlines for administrative internships. Many districts have a required internal application process; the process varies by district and may begin as early as Fall.

| JANUARY 15, 2017 | FAFSA PRIORITY DATE All students are strongly encouraged to fill out a Free Application for Federal Student Aid. This is a critical step to ensure eligibility for a number of scholarship opportunities. The UW Office of Student Financial Aid recommends that applications be submitted by January 15 th to ensure priority processing. |
| FEBRUARY 1, 2017 | DANFORTH APPLICATION DEADLINE Online applications must be submitted and printed copies of all application materials must be received in the Danforth office by 5 p.m. |
| FEBRUARY 18, 2017 | APPLICANT INTERVIEWS Qualified applicants will be invited for an interview by mid-February. This interview will include an on-site instructional performance assessment. <i>State-funded intern applications may be submitted at the time of the interview.</i> |
| MARCH 1, 2017 | STATE-FUNDED INTERN APPLICATIONS, UW REVIEW DEADLINE
Applications for state-provided internship funds can be submitted to the Danforth office (this is an optional step). We will perform an initial review to ensure that applications are complete and meet all requirements. *State review deadline is March 17, 2017. |
| MARCH 15, 2017 | ADMISSIONS DECISIONS Applicants will be notified of admissions decisions by this date via email at the address indicated on their application. Printed letters and additional information will follow via postal mail. |
| MARCH 29, 2017 &
APRIL 4, 2017 | DANFORTH 30 INTERNSHIP PLANNING SESSIONS Admitted applicants have a choice of attending an internship planning session on one of two dates, March 29 or April 4. Both sessions will be held in Miller Hall from 5:00 to 6:30 p.m. |
| MARCH 31, 2017 | LETTERS OF COMMITMENT AND DEPOSIT DUE Admitted applicants must return a letter of commitment and a \$300 deposit to confirm their acceptance into the program. The deposit will be applied to the first quarter's tuition. |
